



Call for Nomination for IEEE ComSoc Young Researcher Award for the Europe, Middle East, and Africa Region



The “IEEE ComSoc Young Researcher Award for the Europe, Middle East, and Africa Region” is sponsored by the IEEE Europe Middle East and Africa (EMEA) Region. This award honors researchers who have been very active in the IEEE through ComSoc publication and conference activities over the last three years.

- ❖ The upper age limit is 35.
- ❖ Applicants must be an IEEE member, and resident in the EMEA Region.
- ❖ The “IEEE ComSoc Young Researcher Award for the EMEA Region” will be awarded to the best candidate.

Award Prize

- ❖ The recipient of “IEEE ComSoc Young Researcher Award for the EMEA Region” will receive a certificate and honorarium of US\$500.
- ❖ The two runner-up outstanding young researchers will each receive a certificate and honorarium of US\$250.

Selection Process

An EMEA Selection Committee, chaired by the EMEA Regional Director, will determine the award recipient(s) from among the eligible applicants. The Committee will then determine two additional outstanding young researchers from the remaining applicants.

Each nominator or applicant must submit an Application to the IEEE ComSoc EMEA Regional Director before the deadline.

Applications should include the following:

- ❖ Applicant’s biography
- ❖ A list of publication and conference activities over the last three years, particularly in IEEE Periodicals. In case of multiple author publication, please explain the role of the nominee.
- ❖ Description of main topics/thesis of the applicant over the last three years. (A4 one page)
- ❖ The cover page should contain the applicant's name, affiliation, address, IEEE Membership Number, telephone, fax number and e-mail address.

- ❖ *30 November 2011: Announcement of Awardees*
