## **Memorandum of Understanding on Academic Co-operation**

**Between  
University of Malaya  
And  
University of Zagreb**

The **UNIVERSITY OF ZAGREB** (Croatia) and the **UNIVERSITY OF MALAYA** (Malaysia), as represented by its Faculty of Law, Faculty of Engineering, and Faculty of Education, hereby agree to stimulate and mutually support co-operative relationship, which will emphasise the development of collaborative educational and research projects. Both universities will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their faculty members, departments, institutes and other research centres subject to the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU").

1. Within the fields of study to be mutually designated, and subject to the rules and regulations applicable in each of the university, the University of Zagreb and the University of Malaya agree to consider the following general forms of co-operation:
  - The exchange of academic staff
  - The exchange of administrative and professional staff
  - The exchange of students within undergraduate and graduate studies
  - Joint organization of courses, study tours, conferences and seminars
  - Organisation of Joint Master Programmes and Doctoral Studies – especially taking into account possibilities of joint programmes in the Centre for Advanced Academic Studies of the University of Zagreb in Dubrovnik
  - Joint research projects, including applications for governmental and foundation funding
  - Other forms of university co-operation of mutual interest.
2. Each university will name a liaison person who will be responsible for co-ordinating activities related to this MoU. On behalf of the University of Zagreb, the International Relations Office shall be the co-ordinating body. On behalf of the University of Malaya the International and Corporate Relations Office (ICR) shall be the co-ordinating body.
3. Terms of joint activities, the conditions for utilising the results achieved, and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges and other forms of co-operation will be negotiated and mutually agreed upon in a separate written agreement for each specific activity. It is also understood that any financial arrangements will be negotiated and agreed to in writing for each specific case and will depend upon the availability of funds.
4. Exchange of academic staff, research scientists, yearly quotas, duration of their stay will be defined in a separately prepared working programme to be mutually agreed upon in writing by both parties. This working programme can be rearranged every three years in accordance of the proposals of the parties to meet the new demands and requirements.
5. The student exchange will be regulated by the special agreement and/or the working programme to be mutually agreed upon in writing between the institutions.

6. Both universities agreed that the medical and accidents insurance expenses during the stay of any exchange staff or student will be covered by the respective participant in the exchange programme.
7. It is understood that this MoU is merely an expression of interest and not intended by the parties to be binding upon each other.
8. This MoU will become effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the two universities and shall remain effective for a period of five (5) years. Amendments may be incorporated with the mutual written consent of both universities. The representative of either university may terminate this MoU by written notice at least six (6) months before its date of expiry. Such termination shall not affect the rights of anybody exchanged under this MoU prior to receipt of such notice.






